Inclusion and branding in various RNF activities

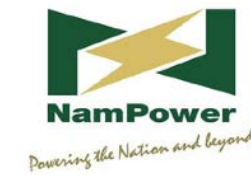

To support and create employment opportunities, either by way of "green jobs" or guiding upcoming SME's to make a sustainable contribution to upholding the 3 R's.

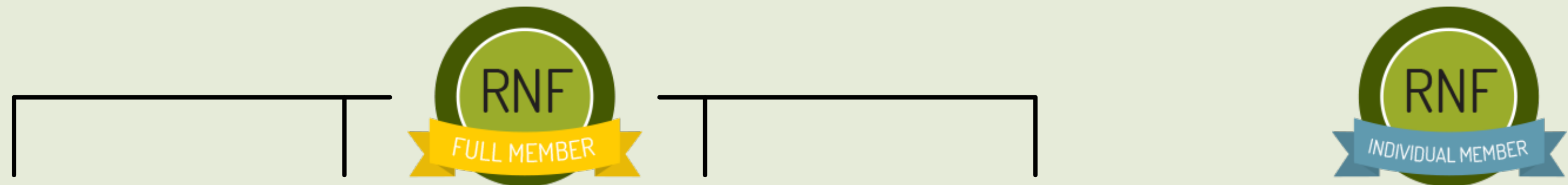
For visible association to the RNF as proof of your commitment to sustainable projects and products.
